Re:	<p>The Petersburg Ranger District is proposing to authorize the installation of a small dam and water transmission line along a small unnamed creek on Kupreanof Island across from Petersburg, Alaska. The six-inch diameter water transmission line would be installed along approximately 300 feet of the creek and would help provide power to a private residence.</p> <p>On May 30, 2018 Forest Service archaeologists conducted a subsurface investigation of the project area and no cultural remains were found. The FS has made a determination of No Historic Properties Affected with project implementation.
